Before we get some shots of Kampala, this is a gratuitous shot of Mount Meru and her cousin Mount Kilimanjaro.



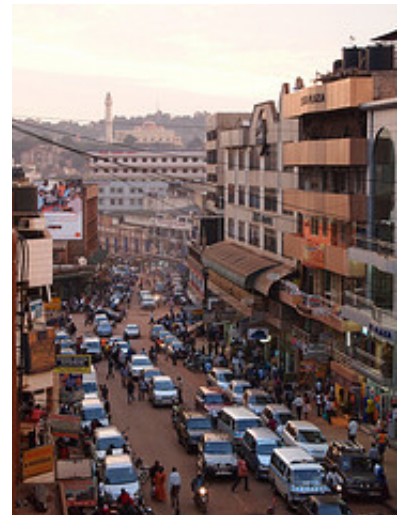
These photos show the market that's just across the street from my hotel.
